Students' council election was conducted very smoothly. The students participated in a discipline manner and casted their votes.



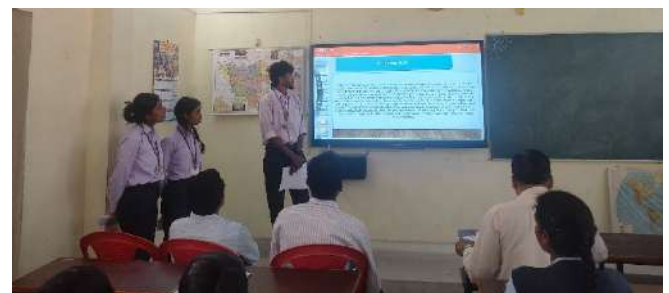
Meeting on Seminar
