
Outcomes

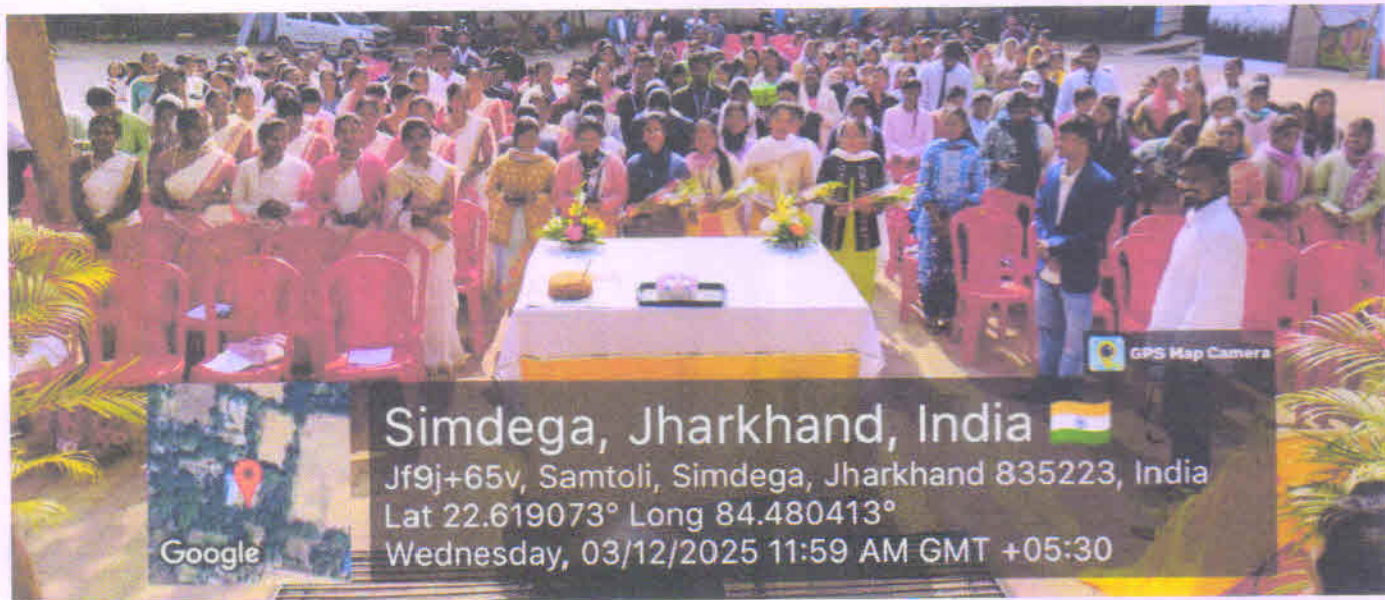
Conclusion
