# Report on the One-Week Workshop (12th-18th July 2025) on Academic Writing of Master's Thesis/Dissertation

A one-week workshop on Academic Writing of Master's Thesis/Dissertation was successfully conducted from 12th to 18th July 2025, with the primary objective of equipping M.A. Semester IV students with the essential skills and techniques required to write their dissertations effectively. 
