St. Xavier's College, Simdega **Annual Report- 2018-19**

Respected, Dr. Kamini Kumar, Pro Vice Chancellor of Ranchi University, Ranchi and the Chief Guest of the College Day Celebrations, Respected Muhammad Multan Ji, Ranchi University, Ranchi, distinguished guests, Rev. Fr. Linus Dundung, the Rector of the College, Respected Professors, all the members of the Supporting Staff, and dear students. On the second Annual Day celebration of the College, it's my great privilege to present the College Annual Report of the year 2019.

Introduction: St. Xavier's College, Simdega is a Religious Minority Educational Institution, maintained by the Ranchi Jesuit Province of the Society of Jesus. St. Xavier's College, Simdega was established on 1st of August 2016 and is affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi. The five founder Jesuits of this College are Dr. Fr. Emmanuel Barla as Principal, Fr. Gilbert D'Souza as Registrar, Fr. Bruno Toppo as Treasurer, Fr. Anup Arvind Ekka as Office In-charge and Scholastic Samir Bhaunra as administrator. The College was started to offer B.Com Degree in Account Honours and B. A. Degree in Economics, History, Geography, Political Science, Hindi and English to the students of Simdega district and of the adjoining areas. When the College started in 2016 there were only 456 students, 11 teachers and 12 members of supporting staff. The College building had only two floors with merely 08 rooms. In February 2019, this College has completed just two and half years. Within this period St. Xavier's College has grown substantially.

On 1st June 2018, the founder principal of the College was transferred to be the principal of St. Xavier's Autonomous College, Ranchi. Fr. Gilbert D'Souza, Registrar of the College, fell sick and so at present he is taking rest in Manresa House, Ranchi. Scholastic Samir Bhaunra went for his further studies. So only two Jesuits - Fr. Bruno and Fr. Anup remained in the College. Very Soon, however, the College got three more Jesuits – In the place of Fr. Barla, the former Principal, the present Acting Principal was appointed on 18th June 2018. Fr. Erenius Toppo was appointed as its Vice- Principal and Deacon Ravi Hemant Kujur was sent to be the Assistant Treasurer. Deacon Ravi was ordained priest on 30th December 2018. In course of time some more persons have joined the College as Professors or as supporting staff.

Students' Enrollment: In the combined efforts of all these people St. Xavier's College, Simdega is growing steadily. In 2017, in the second year of the College, 459 students decided to be admitted in this college, and in the third year in 2018 the number of students taking admission has risen to 517. Total 49 students, however, have discontinued for various reasons, therefore, at present there are 1,383 students in the College, 23 Professors and 14 supporting staff. Like in other educational institutes of the state, in this College also, the number of Girl-Students is more than the boys. The number of boys in the college is 622 where as the number of girl-students is 761.

Development of College Building: During the last two years the size of the College Building also has grown. At present College

Building has four floors, with more than 40 rooms, including 22 class rooms and a Computer Lab.

Achievement of the College:

Improvement in facilities: Efficient Communication is very important in our pursuit of Knowledge. Keeping this in mind St. Xavier's College, Simdega has been able to develop its own website and E. mail Address apart from its official phone number. The College is also equipped with two LCD Projectors also supported by two Generators for electricity.

Preparation for NAAC accreditation: The Principal, Vice-Principal, and two professors – Dr. Jayant Kashyap and Tarun Kanti Xalxo attended the NAAC sponsored National Workshop in Nirmala College Ranchi on 24th to 25th November 2016. They also participated in the UGC sponsored seminar held in the secretariat Building, Dhurwa, Ranchi. After this Internal Quality Assurance Cell has been formed in the college and other works for NAAC have been started.

Achievements of the Faculty:

Participation in the International and National Seminar:

Teaching Programme- conducted by the Teaching Learning Centre, Ramanujan College, University of Delhi from April 9 to May 5, 2018.

Dr. Sunil Kerketta, Department of Hindi Published an article- Hindi Upansyas mei Adivasi Jeewan in “ Akhara” - March- May 2017.

Prof Gaurav Srivastava, Department of Commerce, presented papers – “Importance of Business ethics and Good Governance in Automobile Industry in India” and also on “ Challenges and Future Prospects in Automobile Industry in India. in “Anusandhanika in 2016 and 2017.

Prof Anniruddha Prasad published a paper on “ Socio- Ecocomic Changes in India since Liberalization” in a quarterly Internationally research Journal – “Annals of Multi Disciplinary Research. Vol. 5.

He also attended UGC sponsored International Seminar on “Histroy of Megalithic culture and their Sequential Migration to Asian Countries with an Analytical View of Indian Tribes , organized by Ranchi Unv. Rachi and also presented paper on “ Customs and Rituals of Munda Tribes in Jharkhand. On December 10-12 2018.

Educational Tours: The College believes that Exposure is one of powerful means of obtaining knowledge therefore the College tries to organize some educational Tours. In 2017, the first educational tour was jointly organized by the History and Hindi Departments. On 20th September 2017, 53 students accompanied by two teachers – Manish P. Tirkey and Dr. Sunil Kerketta went for three-day tour to Netarhat Plateau. During this tour they visited Magnolia Sun-Set Point, Netarhat Residential School, Forest Rest House Latehar, Burha Ghagh Waterfall, Latehar, St. Xavier’s College, Mahuadanr, St. Joseph Inter College, Mahuadanr, and Jharkhand Tribal Museum, Gumla. In the year 2018 also, during the Durga Puja Vacation, the various departments of the College arranged Educational Tours to different important and historical places of India. Between 13th Oct. to 18th Oct., the Hindi and History departments jointly arranged the Educational Tour to Odisha. 102 students, accompanied by four teachers- Dr. Sunil Kerketta, Prof. Abahy Ekka, Tarun kanti Xalxo, and Manish Pratap Tirkey, visited various places. These places are Bhubaneshwar, Caves at Udaygiri-Khandgiri, Konark temple, Puri Beach, Chilka Lake, Nandan Kanan oological Park and Raurkela.

On 28th October 2019, 56 students of Commerce Department, in the leadership of Prof. Gaurav Srivastav, Fr. Bruno Toppo, Fr. Ravi

Hemant Kujur, Shree Rakesh kerketta, Prof. Tarun Kanti Xalxo and Mrs Mary Kanta Minj went to Kolkata for educational Tour. They visited the palces like Science City, Indian Museum, Victoriacame back on October. The Department of Geography had a long educational Tour. On 19th October 84 students accompanied by two teachers – Prof. Tarun Dungdung and Prof. Rainy A. Lakr, left for Coimbatore by Dhanbad-Alleppey express . During this 11 day tour they visited the places like Ooty Kodaikanal, Conoor, Kaniakumari, Thiuvanthapuram, Alleppey, Kochi, Periyar lake, and Ernakulam of South India came back to Simdega on 30th October 2018.

Extracurricular Activities :

Yoga day : Yoga Day was arranged in the College premises on 21st June 2018. the students came for the Yaoga at 6.00 o'clock in the morning and had the Yoga in the College quadrangle.

Cleanliness drive: In order to bring awareness among the students the College organized Swachhta Diwas (cleanliness Day) under the banner of NSS on **20th August 2019**. Smt. Pushpa Kullu, the President of Simdega Jila Parishad inaugurated the cleaning programme.

Independence Day and the **Republic day** were Celebrated in the College to inculcate the feeling of patriotism among the students. With the same objective, the College organized the **Condolence Meeting** on 16th February 2019 by lighting the candles when the country experienced the tragic incident of Pulwama attack resulting

in the martyrdom of more than 45 brave soldiers. Apart from the usual Xaverian Feasts on 31st July and 3rd of December, the College also organized the day of Tribal Dance Competition on and Christmas Gathering on 18th December 2018 to give the opportunity to the students to know their culture.

Annual Sports Day : St. Xavier' College Simdega, in the guidance of Sports Committee- Prof. Ananad Minj, Prof. Gaurava Srivastava, Prof. Tarun Dungdung, Fr. Bruno Toppo and Fr. Ravi Hemant Kujur. organized the Annual Sports Day for the first time on Saturday 9th February 2019. More than 400 students participated in 20 different sports events. The Fastest athlete of the College is In the College Sports Bipin Ekka Political Science, Semester- I, is declared the Champion among the boys. He stood 1st in 200 and 400 mtrs race. He was one of the member of the 400x4 relay race also, which got the first rank. Among the girls Sumanti Kullu, Hindi Honours Part- III was declared champion.

Cricket Inter class tournament: The Sports Committee also conducted the Cricket Inter class tournament on 2018. Department of Economics was the winner of the tournament, where as the Department of Commerce was in the second position.

The College Fests and the Annual College Day: In February 2018, College Fest named **Pallava** and College day celebrations were organized successfully. Encouraged by this success even this year the Cultural committee of the College organized the College Fest on 23rd and 24th February 2019. This year College Fest was named Spandan. In the leadership of the committee namely Fr.

Anup Ekka, (the event coordinator), Dr. Jayant Kashyap, Prof Tarun Kanti Xalxo, Prof Rainy Alma Lakra, all the teachers and members of Supporting Staff all the 23 programmes were conducted very smoothly.
