Fr. Pius Xalxo S.J.**, the **Rector** of the College, Respected Professors, all the members of the Supporting Staff, and my dear students.- Good Morning. On the Fifth Annual Day celebration of the College, it's my great privilege to present the **College Annual Report** of the Academic year 2023-2024.

St. Xavier's College, Simdega is a Religious Minority Educational Institution for Higher Education, maintained by the Ranchi Jesuit Province of the Society of Jesus. The College was established on 1st of August 2016 and is affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi. Till last year, i.e. 2023, the College offered B.Com Degree and B. A. Degree but from this year 2024, the college is offering M.Com and M.A. Courses also. In the college classes are held for Commerce, English, Economics, Geography, and History and Political Science subjects. The students of Simdega district and of the adjoining states of Orissa and Chhattisgarh come to this college for their study. At present the College is imparting Higher Education through 23 Professors and 19 Supporting Staff in the College.

Students' Enrollment: In the combined efforts of all these people, Fathers in the Management, Professors and members of the Supporting Staff, St. Xavier's College, and Simdega is growing steadily. When the College started in 2016 there were only 456 students. This year in graduation level there are 447 students in 1st Semester 526 in 2nd Semester and 442 in 5th Semester and there are 105 students for Post graduate studies so all together there are 1415 students in the College.

Unlike previous years, this year number of boys in the college is bigger than that of the girl-students. This year the number of boys in the college is **716** where as the number of girl-students is **699**.

Development of College Building: At present College Building in this campus has five floors, with more than 56 rooms, including 26 class rooms and two Computer Labs. On 2nd of April 2022 the construction of the New Academic block was started in Dhawaipani, Konmenjra, about 7 k.m. south of the present campus. About 60% of the construction work in the new Campus is complete. The college is hopeful that next year the college will move to the new campus at Dhawaipani.

Achievement of the College: In these years the College is continuously developing. It has given the opportunity to the growth and development not only to the students but also to the Professors.

Last year in the college is granted 2 F Certificate from UGC Delhi. After getting this certificate the Professors of the college have become more energetic and active.
